

2024 Nomination Petitions Best Practices

SIGNER REQUIREMENTS

An eligible elector meets all of the requirements to register to vote but does not have to be registered to vote. (Source: Iowa SOS Candidate's Guide)

An eligible elector must be:

- A citizen of the United States
- A resident of lowa
- At least 18 years old

An eligible elector may not:

- Be a convicted felon (unless voting rights have been restored by the president or governor, including through an executive order)
- Be currently judged incompetent to vote by a court
- Claim the right to vote in any other place

TIPS + BEST PRACTICES

- Quality over quantity! Take the time to make sure every signer meets the requirements and is filling out accurate information
- Use the pre-filled, approved petition forms. If you run out, contact your county lead or the campaign
- Make sure the signer lives in the correct county listed on the sheet before you give it to them
- Ensure the name, address, and date are legible for verification
- The address can not be a PO Box and should be their physical residence address
- The signer should only sign for themselves and no one else- this means that they
 shouldn't sign for a family member including for their spouse, child, parent, etc.
- Fill out the cover sheet (flip) to turn in with your petitions with the full contact information
